<u>Tree Program</u> – Carlson gave an update on the Tree program for Spring 2023. An estimated 13,000 trees have been ordered from numerous nurseries. An estimated 14 tree plantings are planned for the shall SWCD for 4,500 Trees. 4 of these tree plantings will utilize the Pennington SWCD Tree aoric Program.

<u>Drill Program</u> – Carlson gave an update on the Drill program. Currently 30 sites/landowners are scheduled for the Marshall SWCD to plant their site. These sites added up are currently at an estimated 850 Acres.

Overtime/Staff Compensation during non-core hours (Drill Program – Tabled until the April 19, 2023 Marshall SWCD Board Meeting.

<u>Aquatic Invasive Species (AIS) Funds</u> - Motion by Larson and seconded by Walton to continue working with Curt Quesnell and the "Clean, Drain, Dry" Promotion for use of the AIS Funds.

Area Meeting – Carlson brought up that there will be an Area Meeting I in Mahnomen on March 21. Marshall SWCD will be hosting.

<u>Swift Coulee Project</u> – Carlson gave a report on the Swift Coulee Project. Earthen berms offset are being proposed by the Middle/Snake/Tamarac Watershed District to help with out of bank flooding and to help reduce flooding. 40 parcels will be affected. The state funded Re invest in Minnesota (RIM) program (which the Marshall SWCD helps administrate) will be used to help with the acquisition of the ground where this project will take place. Landowners are being encouraged to stop in and talk to the Marshall SWCD or NRCS to discuss about CCRP or CRP options to maximize their dollar potential. RIM is a lengthy process. Not all landowners are on board as of yet.

Office Water Cooler – Carlson brought up that currently Marshall SWCD & NRCs Staff are currently paying for the Water Cooler. Carlson asked if it would be ok for the payments to come from Marshall SWCD. Water Cooler will be used by Staff, Board Members and landowners. Motion by Larson and seconded by Walton for the Marshall SWCD to pay for the water.
